### WHAT IS A TIP VOLUNTEER?

TIP is a group of specially-trained volunteers who provide immediate emotional and practical support and resources to survivors of traumatic events. TIP Volunteers are called by law enforcement, fire, and EMS personnel to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, homicide, suicide, accidental, infant), industrial accidents, sexual assaults, overdoses, violent crime, and other traumatic incidents.
